General Notes for the School Year (may be adjusted as the year moves forward):

- We will follow the St. John school guidelines for face coverings, handwashing, sanitizing, and social distancing.
- The students will eat lunch in the classroom, and recesses will be staggered amongst the classes.
- Students may want to bring an old towel or small blanket for when we sit outside for class or other activities.
- When MAPS testing, the time slot in the schedule will be 2:15 - 3:15 pm on Monday-Wednesday. (Catch-up will be during Study Hall for the rest of the week, as needed.)
- If the students are done with their work by Study Hall, they can use that time to practice typing or read a book. They could also practice their spelling words, or study for a quiz or test the next day.
- This year is projected to be a Social Studies Fair for the Shoreland Academic Fair, so start thinking about what event from history or current events you would like to report on. (If needed, this project will be done with a video presentation rather than attending the fair in-person.)
- Singing for church and for Junior Choir are suspended until further notice. However, we may record singing in-class and incorporate it into St. John church's online services.

All-Class Learning from Home

- If a switch to **all**-remote learning is made for all students in the class, we will follow the same schedule as the school day (ending slightly earlier). With remote instruction, daily emphasis will be given on Word of God, language arts, and math. Science and social studies will be addressed on a weekly basis, and STEM, technology, art, music, current events, and Spanish will be optional.

 - 10 am - 6th Math (together over Zoom) & 5th Math work time
 - 10:30 - Morning Break (snack/exercise)
 - 10:45 - Language Arts: Grammar & Writing (together over Zoom, then independent work time)
 - 11:20 am - Language Arts: Novel Study (independent)
 - 12 pm - Lunch & Exercise break
 - 12:45 pm - Afternoon Devotion
 - 1 pm - Science/Social Studies/Spelling class or work time (independent)
 - 1:45 pm - Optional activities (Duolingo, STEM, art, music, current events)
 - 2 pm - Work Time & Virtual Office Time for Mrs. Wintrone (over Zoom)
 - 5 pm - Office Time Ends
