

# Memory Treasures 2020-2021

## Weekly Bible passage or Commandment:

The students should be prepared to say or write each passage on the last day of the week.

- 8/21      **Ephesians 6:1** - Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
- 8/28      **John 1:29** -Look! The Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
- 9/3        **1 Peter 5:8** - Have sound judgment. Be alert. Your adversary, the Devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.
- 9/11      **The 5th Commandment** - You shall not murder. *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and befriend him in every bodily need.
- 9/18      **Romans 6:23** - For the wages of sin is death, but the undeserved gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 9/25      **The 3rd Commandment** - Remember the Sabbath Day by keeping it holy. *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but regard it as holy and gladly hear and learn it.

- 10/2      **Romans 10:17** - Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message comes through the word of Christ.
- 10/9      **Matthew 11:28** - Come to me all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- 10/16     **John 14:19** - In a little while the world will see me no longer, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.
- 10/23     **Ephesians 4:32** - Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ has forgiven you.
- 10/28     **The 1st Commandment** - You shall have no other gods. *What does this mean? We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.*
- 11/6      **Proverbs 3:5** - Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding.
- 11/13     **Psalms 50:15** - Call on me in the day of distress. I will deliver you, and you will honor me.
- 11/20     **1 John 1:7** - The blood of Jesus Christ, his Son, cleanses us from all sin.
- 12/4      **Matthew 22:37-39** - 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. The second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

- 12/11 **Galatians 4:4-5** - But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son to be born of a woman, so that he would be born under the law, in order to redeem those under the law, so that we would be adopted as sons.
- 12/18 **Luke 2:10** - But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. For behold, I bring you good news of great joy, which will be for all people."
- 1/8 **Psalm 103:1** - Bless the LORD, O my soul. All that is within me, bless his holy name.
- 1/15 **Psalm 139:14** - I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.
- 1/22 **Psalm 118:1** - Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his mercy endures forever.
- 1/29 **2 Timothy 3:16** - All Scripture is God breathed.
- 2/5 **Ephesians 2:8-9** - It is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast.
- 2/12 **John 11:25** - I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me will live, even if he dies.
- 2/19 **Mark 10:45** - For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

- 2/25      **The 1st Article** - I believe in God the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.
- 3/5        **Matthew 6:33** - But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- 3/12      **Matthew 26:41** - Watch and pray, so that you do not enter into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.
- 3/19      **John 3:16** - For God so loved the world that he gave his only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
- 4/1        **The 2nd Article** - I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.
- 4/9        **Job 19:25** - I know that my Redeemer lives.
- 4/16      **The 3rd Article** - I believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy Christian church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.

- 4/23 **The 2nd Commandment** - You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your *God*. *What does this mean?* We should fear and love *God* that we do not use his name to curse, swear, lie, or deceive, or use witchcraft, but call upon *God's* name in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.
- 4/30 **Matthew 28:19-20** - Therefore go and gather disciples from all nations by baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and by teaching them to keep all the instructions I have given you. And surely I am with you always until the end of the age.
- 5/7 **Matthew 18:20** - In fact where two or three have gathered together in my name, there I am among them.
- 5/14 **Romans 1:16** - For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of *God* for salvation to everyone who believes.
- 5/21 **Isaiah 41:10** - Do not fear, for I am with you. Do not be overwhelmed, for I am your *God*.
- 5/27 **1 Timothy 2:3-4** - This is good and pleasing in the sight of *God* our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
