Its so exciting to see how well the students are doing with their reading and all of our new words! Please continue to work with the flashcards that come home and review the work in their workbooks!

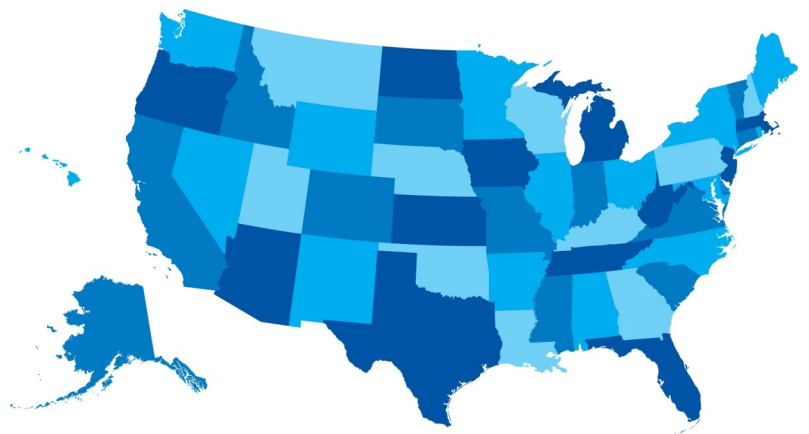
Social Studies
