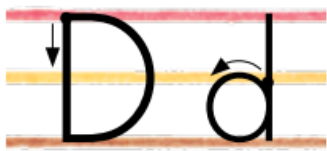
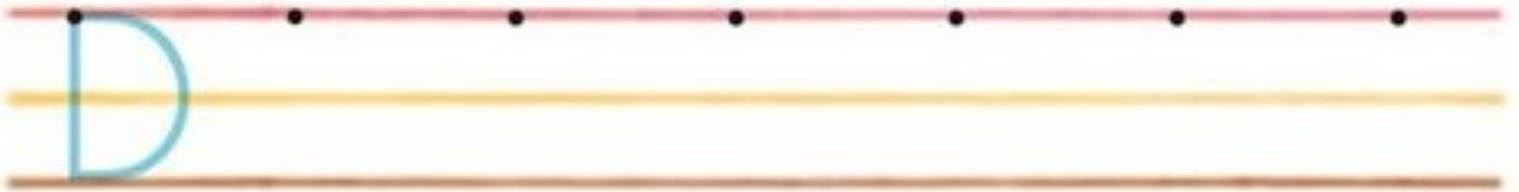
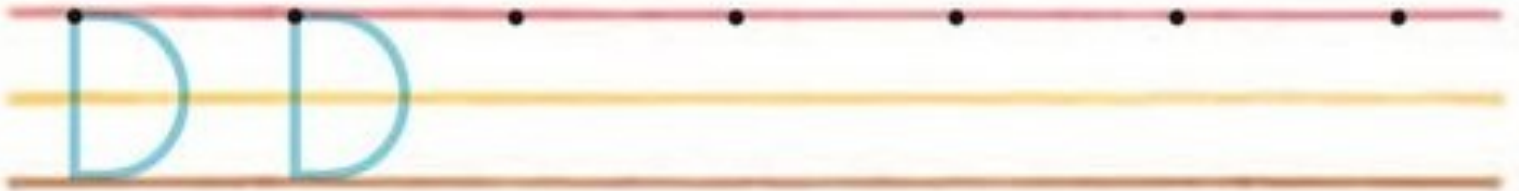
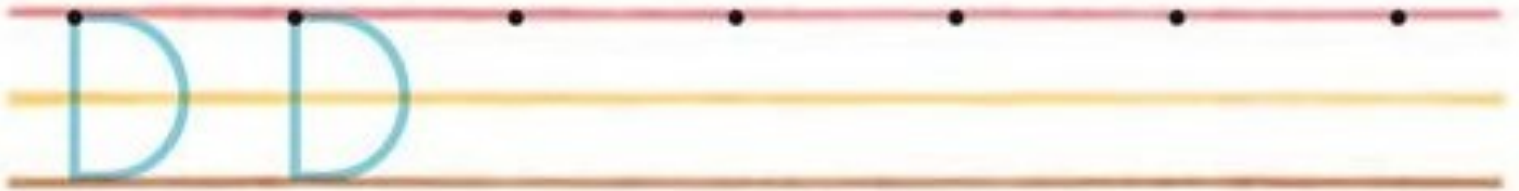
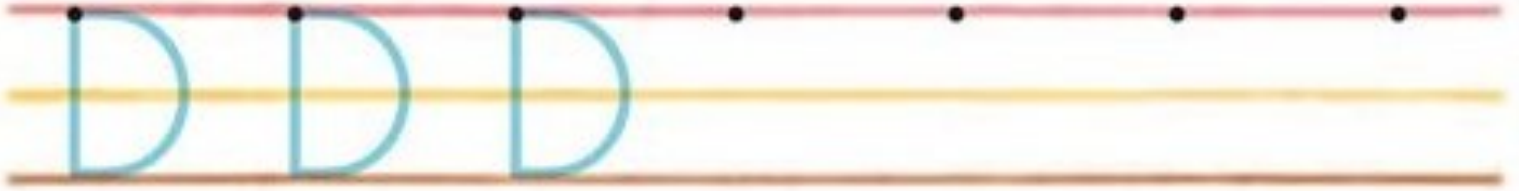
Memory Treasure - Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

Capital D. Start at the top strawberry line and draw a straight line down to the bottom chocolate

line. Lift your pencil and go back to where you started. Make a big stomach on the *D*. Curve through the middle vanilla line and then back to the bottom chocolate line so that the stomach looks like a half circle.



Lowercase *d*. Start right below the middle vanilla line and make a circle. Without lifting your pencil, make a straight line up to the top strawberry line. Then come back down the line you made
