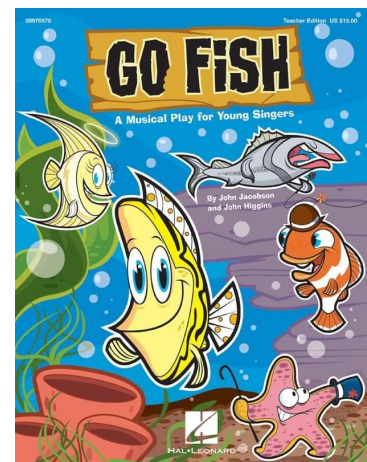

Math We are continuing to practice "counting on" and using manipulatives to see how two groups come together to make a larger total. We will begin exploring what happens when we "take away" from a group. We are learning that subtraction is the opposite of addition!



Christ Light This week, we are learning the powerful story of the ten men Jesus healed. We are exploring the themes of faith and, most importantly, the "attitude of gratitude."

While all ten men were healed of their sickness, only one returned to fall at Jesus' feet and say "Thank you."

This story is helping us practice:

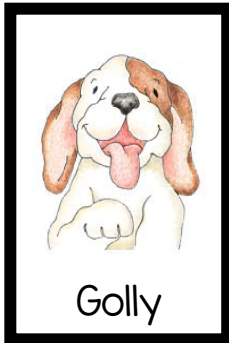

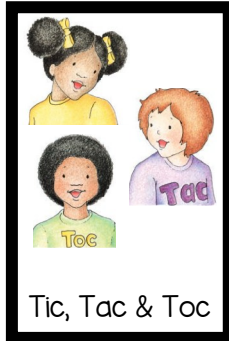

Uppercase B—Touch the strawberry line; **pull down straight** to the chocolate line. **Lift.**

Touch the strawberry line; **slide right; curve forward** to the vanilla line; **slide left. Slide right; curve forward** to the chocolate line. **Slide left.**

Lowercase b—Touch the strawberry line; **pull down straight** to the chocolate line. **Push up; circle forward** all the way around.

Superkids We continue Unit 14 of our Superkids reading program. We get to tag along with our Superkids as they create their very own club! Our focus will be on:

Mastering Bb and Rr: We are practicing the /b/ sound (as in *bus* and *rabbit*) and the /r/ sound.

The "Bat Before the Ball" Trick: To help us write our lowercase b facing the right way (and avoid those tricky b/d reversals), we are practicing the "bat before the ball" stroke order.

Blending: We'll be using these new letters to build and read even more words
